



The Fourteenth Pilgrimage of Hadrian's Wall 20th - 28th July 2019

PROGRAMME OUTLINE Saturday 20 July to Sunday 28 July 2019

The Pilgrimage will be held from 20 to 28 July 2019. We will be based at the Royal Station Hotel in Newcastle for the first four nights and the County Hotel in Carlisle for the second four. Travel will be by four coaches, but there will be opportunities for walking. The programme has been designed to illustrate recent work on Hadrian's Wall, as well as visits to the traditional sites and to museums. There will be two main themes to the Pilgrimage: sites which illustrate the building of the Wall, and those which illuminate its history in the third and fourth centuries. On several days there will be receptions. All Pilgrims will be issued with a copy of a special handbook detailing work on the Wall over the last ten years edited by Drs R Collins and M Symonds. There will be special book stalls on two evenings. On Wednesday, the Pilgrimage will move from Newcastle to Carlisle and that day will be spent at Vindolanda, reflecting the amount to inspect at that site; the day will close with a hog roast. The registration fee includes site entries, lunches and dinners, and the handbook.

The principal guides will be Dr Mike Bishop, Dr Rob Collins, Erik Graafstal, Dr Nick Hodgson, Professor Valerie Maxfield, Graeme Stobbs, Dr Matt Symonds and Tony Wilmott.

Both hotels are immediately adjacent to railway stations and we hope that this will render it easier for Pilgrims to travel by train. On the first day, there will be a coach from Kendal, through Penrith and Carlisle to Newcastle with coaches returning to Kendal and to Newcastle on Sunday 28 July.
